NAPLAN Online Update



Malvern Springs Primary School will be participating in the online version of NAPLAN testing in 2019. This is our second year of our NAPLAN Online participation and we are anticipating another successful year. Soon you will receive more information if your child is in Year 3 or Year 5.

The 2019 information pamphlet for parents and carers answers many of the most frequently asked questions about NAPLAN testing, such as 'How can I help my child prepare for the test?' and 'What are the benefits of NAPLAN Online?'

We recommend you read the information and speak to your child's classroom teacher if you have any further questions or concerns. NAPLAN testing starts on Tuesday the 14th of May and the testing window closes on the Friday the 24th of May, so all our Year 3 and Year 5 students can complete their tests online.

Mental Health & Wellbeing Across MSPS

This year the school is taking onboard a well-researched whole school social and emotional program from Kindy to Year 6, ***Friendly Schools Plus***.



“Friendly Schools is the first anti-bullying initiative for schools developed through extensive research with Australian children and adolescents. It is recognised nationally and internationally as a comprehensive, evidence-based approach to student health and wellbeing that can substantially reduce bullying behaviour. The Friendly Schools initiative has been designed to align with both the Australian Curriculum and the National Safe Schools Framework.”

Every class has the resources to begin the program and school staff have attended professional learning on how to run the program. A follow up professional learning session will occur next term to further assist the teachers with embedding the program across the school to assist our children with their social and emotional development to empower them to resolve conflict in a diplomatic and positive way.
