School Crosswalk



The streets around Malvern Springs Primary School are frequently busy with motor vehicles. Please take some time to remind students that before entering the crosswalk, students should make sure that all vehicles have come to a complete stop and to use their manners to our lovely crosswalk attendants.

Student Attendance

At Malvern Springs Primary School we value and promote each student receiving a great education, the building blocks for a great education begin with students coming to school each and every day. When students miss school regularly, they miss out on learning the fundamental skills that will set them up for success in the later years of school. There is no safe number of days for missing school – each day a student misses puts them behind, and can affect their educational outcomes. If your child is away for any reason, we ask that you advise the school as soon as possible.



Positive Behaviour Support

Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) is a set of research-based strategies used to increase quality of life and decrease problem behaviour by explicitly teaching new skills and making changes in a student's environment.

At Malvern Springs Primary School, teachers will be explicitly teaching observable behaviours that directly relate to the four behaviour expectations. These observable behaviours are taught to students fortnightly and will be displayed on classroom communication boards. Students who are seen demonstrating the behaviour expectations will be rewarded with faction tokens which are entered into a weekly prize draw.
